## ABOUT THE TRAIL

The property was acquired in 2017 for \$2.6 million. Grant funding was generously provided from the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund and the Transportation Alternatives Program through the Michigan Department of Transportation. Additional funding for construction was provided by MDOT and the Ralph C. Wilson, Jr Foundation. A pedestrian bridge over M-5 was constructed in 2018.

In 2020, Phase Two will begin work, from Downtown Wixom to the Huron Valley Trail. A temporary connector is open. The Michigan Air Line Trail is part of the Great Lake to Lake Trails [Route 1], a cross-Michigan destination trail that extends from Port Huron to South Haven.
